2. To briefly look at the history of limestone production and lead mining on the mountain
3. To compare two quarry operations from their boundary Pant Pwl y Dwr GR 190720; Aberdo (Bryn Mawr) GR 187734
4. Visit Pen yr Henblas - chert quarry GR 197728
5. Visit Maes Mynan sand and gravel quarry GR 114722
