<u>Field Meeting to Almeria, SE Spain – 3rd-10th January 2016</u> With Graham Sherwood

P.T.O. for details

From Liverpool John Lennon Airport we fly to Malaga, then drive to Almeria City where we will be based. Almeria is a geological young region — many of the rocks having been formed in the last 10 million years, filling basins between the mountains uplifted as a result of the African — Eurasian collision. This is the driest part of Europe and so the exposure is excellent. We will examine a wide range of rocks; Metamorphic Rocks, such as Marble and Tourmaline Gneiss, Sedimentary Rocks, from Limestones through Turbidites to gypsum evaporates, and volcanic rocks, both lavas and volcaniclastic rocks, some with very unusual compositions. We will see evidence of ancient seismic activity with some spectacular syn-sedimentary deformation, as well as a major fault zone. If time permits we will throw in a hot spring and an abandoned gold mine, as well as a visit to Los Millares, one of the most important Copper Age archaeological sites in Europe, and in Almeria itself the Moorish Alcazaba and air-raid shelters from the Spanish Civil War.
