"The Formby Oil Field - & Fracking!?" By Prof Richard Worden (Univ of Liverpool)

The Formby oil field was one of the first commercial oil fields in the UK. It was discovered in the lead up to the Second World War following reports of oil seepages in fields and ditches in West Lancashire. Much deeper, below the Formby Oil Field Permo-Triassic succession, there is the possibility of fracking commercial accumulations of shale gas in the thick, organic rich and thermally mature Carboniferous Bowland Shale.
