## Sat 21st May 2016 Field Meeting from 11:00 am!

### **Exciting Glacial Deposits in North Wales! With Prof Richard Chiverrell (University of Liverpool)**

Prof. Richard Chiverrell (Uni of L'pool) will lead a day field excursion to examine the glacial deposits of N Wales studied as part of the BRITICE project. We will visit two locations on the N Wales Coast. At Dinas Dinlle - drumlin deposits that were remobilised by subsequent glacial advance. If you think that thrust and nappe structures are only features of mountain belts: think again!

**Later in the day** we will move to **Aberogwen** to see some ice-dammed lake deposits that formed between the two ice masses; recently dated for first time.

**Meet at 11.00 am at the Car Park (cafe available) at Dinas Dinlle (beyond Caernarfon off the A499 - Grid Reference SH436565 Nearest Post Code - LL54 5TW)** for a short walk on to the iron age hill fort on the top of a drumlin for an overview of the site. Then an easy walk along the sandy beach to see the cross section and the tectonics. **Second Location: Aberogwen**, on the Menai Straits, **East of Penrhyn Castle SH 615 723, LL57 3YH. Boots and hard hats recommended. Participants should bring lunch etc.**
