Sad News: Dr Geoffrey Tresise

It is with great sadness that we wish to report that **Dr Geoffrey Tresise** passed away recently. Geoff had been a long-standing member of the Liverpool Geological Society and joined the Society soon after arriving in Liverpool to start work at Liverpool Museum in 1960. He was President of the Society from 1999 to 2001 and, for many years, served as Honorary Assistant Secretary and as a Holding Trustee of the Society. Geoff is known for his work at Liverpool Museum, and, although he retired in 1996, Geoff continued working on the collections in the Earth Sciences section of the renamed World Museum Liverpool. Geoff was a friend to many people in the Society and was always keen to share his knowledge of the tracks of the Triassic vertebrates of NW England. He will be very sadly missed.
